Instructions for collection of a single soil sample

1. Choose the sample area (i.e. front yard, back yard, garden spot, crop field)
2. Remove the organic matter (i.e. leaves, rocks, grass, debris) from the top of the soil and
3. With a clean garden trowel or shovel dig a 6" deep hole (it can be as small as your fist in diameter).
4. Collect approximately **1 cup** of the soil from the bottom of the hole to use as your sample.

Instructions for collection of large or multiple sites

1. Every ¼ acre take 2 to 4 samples (using the single sample above for each sample.)
2. Mix those 4 to 5 samples together in a clean bucket or container and then
3. bring **1 cup** of the soil from the bucket or container to use as your sample

••• PLEASE NOTE •••

- Soil should not be muddy or waterlogged
- Avoid collecting samples along a driveway or near a compost pile
- Always use a different bucket or container to mix each set of samples together
